



DOMINIC'S RAZOR WIELDED IN RAGE

Plays Havoc With the Italian
Beauty of Rosa Paul,
Coquette.

BOTH HELD UNDER BONDS.

Other Offenders at the Police Bar of
Justice—Five Dollars' Worth
Of Swearing.

For an hour yesterday Rosa Paul, with the livid scars upon her face barely concealed with the white powder, sat in the witness' box of the police courtroom, whiling away the time in a flirtation with a man on the prisoner's bench, while directly behind her and watching her every move sat Dominic Albanese, the man who slashed her nine times with a razor.

At the end of the hour the Italian woman, listened, with a smile curling about her lip, to her former lover deny that he had attempted to take her life by assaulting her with a deadly weapon, laughed when he was held under \$750 bonds, and then broke into tears when the court ordered that she either give \$250 bond or be detained in the custody of the sheriff to insure her appearance as the complaining witness against Albanese, on Aug. 23.

Rosa Paul, coquette, according to her own story, was the victim of the jealous rage of Albanese, a rage inflamed with all the passion of the Latin blood. A week ago last Saturday Albanese, the discarded lover of a month, who had been thrown away by the woman, entered her room about midnight and with little more than a word began slashing her with a razor. Before she could escape he had inflicted nine cuts upon the face, breast, arms and back. The screams of the woman attracted a number on the street and when Albanese attempted flight he ran into the arms of two deputy sheriffs.

Albanese was represented by counsel in court and pleaded not guilty. Asst. County Atty. Bowman asked that his bonds be fixed at \$1,000, but Atty. A. J. Weber argued effectively that the defendant through his friends might be able to secure \$750. A peculiar feature of the case arose in Atty. Weber's evident anxiety to release the prosecuting witness. Prosecutor Bowman asked that the woman, the complaining witness, be held under \$500 to insure her appearance. Mr. Bowman plainly intimating that when the case was called there might be the possibility of neither the defendant nor the witness being present. Atty. Weber ventured the



SALOONS DID NOT CLOSE. Ordinance Openly Violated, but Stewart Speaks of "Understanding."

With few exceptions, the saloons did not close until 2 o'clock this morning. Most of them were wide open, but others did business behind screens. It is stated that in several places the bartenders served drinks all night. This is in violation of the ordinance which was passed several months ago closing the saloons at midnight.

The saloon men declare that they were given permission to keep open until 2 o'clock in the morning during G. A. R. week. Chief of Police Sam Barlow says that there is no chance that the ordinance should be enforced. The patrolman on the downtown beats did not interfere with the saloons, and evidently carried out orders.

Councilman J. J. Stewart, chairman of the license committee, said that the matter had not been before the council or the committee but it was the general understanding that the saloon men should be given some leeway during the encampment. Stewart once before entered into a personal agreement with
