THE LONDON BOAT RACE.

The Oxford Students Came out Victorious.

LONDON, March 21.—The forty-eighth boat race between Oxford and Cambridge was decided this morning. It was won by a quarter of a length by Oxford. Time, 22 minutes. The race was over the usual course, from Putney Bridge to a ship at Mortlake. About four and a quarter miles, owing to the "stop" stage of the course. It is in favor of the right hand or starboard position, while the left or burry side has the best for the next two miles, and the best advantage for the next mile and a quarter. This year the tide was high at London Bridge at 11.30, and at Putney one hour later. The whole course was crowded with spectators.

The attendance was a whole lot more than that of former years, owing to the early hour at which the race was rowed, and to the prevalence of clear and bright weather. The wind was light and the water was smooth.

Oxford won the low end of the Middlesex, and the high end also. The eight started readily and quickly, and at 11.30 sharp.
