AN OGDES HOTEL KEEPER

Bald in Bonds of \$5000 on a Charge of Embezzlement.

Charles H. Preston, proprietor of the Brunswick hotel at Ogden, has been held to await the action of the grand jury by Judge Cross, in bonds of \$5000, on the charge of embezzlement.

The defendant was arrested July 5th, at Cheyenne, by the Wyoming officers on a dispatch from Marshal McGaugh. Thursday morning, June 26th, two sheep herders named Beemer and Devor went to Ogden to spend their hard-earned dollars and gave \$200 into Preston's care for safe keeping. The hotel keeper at once deposited the money with the Utah State Trust Company and the evening took Union Pacific No. 1 which leaves at 6 o'clock, for the East.

When questioned regarding his pecuniary affairs in the matter, Preston stated that he had no money in his pocket except what he received the evening of his departure. He had received word that a woman with whom he had been guilty of sexual relations was threatening to expose him if he did not pay a sum of money to her. A telegram was sent to him from the Carnegie company.
