As Stockholder in Two Companies He Enters Court for an Accounting.

DENIED BOOKS FOR INQUIRY.

Order is Issued Requiring Officers to Show Cause Why Plaintiff Should Not Examine Records.

George S. Kimball, who filed suit Wednesday against the Continental Life Insurance company of Salt Lake to compel its officers to allow him to examine the books, brought a similar suit yesterday against the officers and directors of the Western Securities company of Arizona, which has offices in this city.

The defendants in the two suits are the same with two exceptions. The directors of the Continental Life Insurance company, W. S. McCormick, John Derr, W. R. Rice, W. H. Cunningham and H. C. Edwards, control the Western Securities company. Besides these Dr. Harry N. Mayo and J. P. Dunn are named as defendants in the latter suit.

It is alleged that the two companies have been fraudulently transferring and juggling the stocks and assets of the two companies until the financial standing can not be determined by the other stockholders.

He sets out in his complaint that he demanded the officers of the Western Securities company to allow him to see the books and was refused. In a circular set out in the complaint it is shown that the Arizona concern had received from the Continental Life company 1,234 shares of stock valued at \$175,236.40 which stock had been held with other stock as collateral security by the insurance company for the payment of an indebtedness of \$120,123.26 of the Western Securities company. The insurance company is charged with releasing the collateral security from the payment of this debt and assuming obligations of the latter concern to the amount of \$33,500 in consideration of the assignment and transfer by the Western company to the insurance company of notes, accounts and other assets and the consent of the Western company to cancel a contract existing between the two companies, the value of which is placed in the statement at \$217,673.12.

Kimball further states that it is proposed to distribute to the 3,254 shares of capital stock of the Continental Insurance company of the value of \$27,618.60 among part of the stockholders of the Western Securities in the stock held in the company. Then Kimball alleges it is proposed to distribute the remaining assets of the Western Securities company and disincorporate. Kimball is a stockholder in both companies and asks to see the books. He wants to know the value of the notes and the nature of the contract between the two companies on which this transfer is made. An order was issued returnable May 8, when the officers will be required to show cause why they should not allow Kimball to see the books and accounts of the two companies.

**STEVENSONS PARTED.**

Clara Stevenson has been granted a divorce from William Stevenson by Judge Armstrong on the ground of desertion. They were married on April 15, 1906, in Salt Lake.

**MINING CLAIMS IN DISPUTE.**

The Verno Mining company has filed suit against the Utah Copper Plate Mining company in the district court to gain possession of eight mining claims in the Draper Mining district in Salt Lake county. It is alleged that the defendants have taken possession of the property. An order was asked to bring the officers of the company, Charles Bradford, Archibald and Sparrow and James Barr into court to set up their claims to the property.

**MAUD HUNT DESERTED.**

Mrs. Maud Hunt brought action for divorce against J. A. Hunt yesterday in the district court, on the charge of desertion. The marriage was contracted in 1902, and she married on Feb. 11, 1902, and Hunt deserted her in April, 1907. She asks for the custody of their minor children and \$20 a month alimony.

**NATURALIZATION DAY.**

Tomorrow will be naturalization day in the United States district court. At 10 o'clock Judge Marshall will consider a number of applications for citizenship. The list is expected to be a longer one than usual, as no court for this purpose was held last month.

**BANK WANTS THE MONEY.**

Another turn taken in effort to dispossess Price.

Another turn was given yesterday to the suit over the package of money, amounting to \$2,430, which was given to Charles Price by the Oregon bank, of Portland, Oregon, through its attorney, P. L. Williams of this city, is pending the decision of the court to declare the bank a party in the suit that has been going on for some time. It alleges that the money was given to Price as a part of that which was stolen from the East Side bank in December, 1908, and the above motion is being made with the view of obtaining possession.

**SMOKE CASES DISMISSED.**

In the federal court yesterday the smelter smoke damage suits of Oscar J. Reese and A. A. Reese against the Utah Con. Mining company and John F. Lennberg against the same company were both dismissed with costs against the plaintiff by Judge John A. Marshall. It is understood that in both cases settlements have been made out of court.
