County Records of Utah County Disclose No Frauds Thus Far.

Provo, Utah Co., Jan. 18.—It is not believed that many, if any, fraudulent bounty claims have been presented or allowed in this county. On several occasions attempts have been made to pass in skins entitled to a small bounty as skins of animals which bring a larger bounty, such as a coyote for a wolf, etc., but when discovered they have been turned down. There is no record kept in the clerk's office, except the certificate book, which contains the stubs of the certificates issued. From a not very thorough inspection of these stubs, it does not appear that many hides of bears, mountain lions or wolves have been presented for bounty. The large majority of the bounties are from coyotes and most of them have been brought from the western part of this county, and from Tooele county.
