Foreign Notes.

LONDON, Feb. 20.—Middleton, publisher of the "Morning Post," has been arrested by the police on a charge of publishing a libelous article in his paper of the 15th inst. The article, which was published in the "Morning Post," contained a number of statements which were alleged to be untrue and which reflected upon the character of the late Queen Victoria. Middleton was arrested at his residence in the Strand, and is now being held in custody at the police station.

The article also intimated that a fear existed that the Mansion House relief fund might be misapplied. The case was adjourned till Saturday.

In the House of Commons today the Chancellor of the Exchequer gave notice that he would move on Monday next for the appointment of a select committee to inquire into the question of loans for public works from the consolidated fund.

Stanhope, Under Secretary for India, announced that a telegram had been received from the British Assistant Quartermaster General, concerning the dispatch of troops to the Crimea.

The Chancellor of the Exchequer said there was no intention of resuming negotiations regarding the silver question started by the United States, and discussed at the Paris conference.

Lord Hartington asked for further information respecting the attempt on the life of the Emperor.
