The following poem has given to the English language one of the most useful words. Every one is familiar with the first line, but how many persons know the poem from which it is taken? This poem is said to have been first printed in 1598. The author is unknown:

NOTES.

The title of Marie Corelli's new story, which will be published on Sept. 15, is "The Secret of the Island of Man." It is a novel of the island of Man, and is a sequel to her previous work, "The Sorrows of Satan."
