BLAINE DYING.

That is the Message Wired
From Washington

TO A NEW YORK PAPER.

The Ex-Secretary's Death May Be
Expected Any Day.

A CONFECTING REPORT.

Blacks' Friends State That the
Emancipation Movement Is Much
Better Now.

New York, Dec. 14.—The following special was received from Washington tonight by a local paper:

James G. Blaine is on his death bed. The strength-sapping malady from which he has suffered for so long a time, has assumed a form which warns the family and friends of a speedy termination. The disease apparently urges a short course, and death has left the staff of physicians. There are reasons to believe that the ex-secretary's death may occur at any day. A strong letter previously sent to the Senate by the president of the Senate, indicating that it is Blaine's desire to be buried in the grounds of the National Cemetery, was a contribution to his deathbed. Father Dwyer, who visited the Blaine residence naturally accounted for the talk.

Another Assassination Plot.

VALPARAISO, Dec. 14.—Another plot of the followers of the late President Masaryk has been discovered by the government at Santiago and a general search was made to intercept the second regiment, and the plot became known to the government shortly before the evening. The police enclosed the barracks, barring the exits and searched several places of concentration. The plot was to seize various points in the city, which was to be sacked, and lots of prominent government officials who were to be killed were found; also a number of maps, daggers, revolvers, etc. Forty-four persons were in custody. They are all adherents of the seventh regiment, which was to march to the Grand Central station to take the train for his home at Valparaiso.

Rome, Dec. 14.—Much irritation exists at the Vatican on account of attacks made by certain American Catholic journalists on the person and the institutions of Pope Leo XIII. It is learned that the opposition to the policy of the pope, the Vatican may cause an inquiry to be made into the origin. The holy father desires his agents shall be removed, and that the papers which have written against the United States shall be followed. If there be any need of it, the pope will, in this instance, also take severe measures with those who oppose his intentions. It is believed here that the Vatican knows from whence the hostile criticisms proceed.
