KANSAS CITY, 6.—A Jefferson City special has a letter from Frank James addressed to Governor Crittenden, dated St. Louis, October 1st. This letter from James professes a surrender. It is a lengthy document, and says he was prompted to act through consideration for his wife and children and a desire to retire his name from the shadow cast upon it, and through it upon the good name of Western Missourians.

They show that the interest on the United States debt, in 1885 it was at its height, being \$4.25; in the following year, \$4.12; a year later, \$3.90; it gradually decreased to \$3.10 in 1891; it has fallen to \$1.00, and soon must be below that.
