## SERIOUS ACCIDENT TO A GINSAN.

Shooting Mishap.—Reward for a Missing Man—Preparing for Dr. Tinker's Execution.

A new postoffice has been established at Parkers, Kane County, Utah.

At Cervallis, Oregon, Judge Miller ordered the release of an unregistered sale of the Oregon Pacific railroad property by the sheriff on or before December 1st.

E. B. Thomas, superintendent of the Spring Hill mine at Grass Valley, Cal., has settled with \$2000 which was paid him by the company to pay the wages of miners. He took a quantity of dynamite from the mill. A search is being made for him. At present there is no clue as to where he is.

The Idaho Statesman is offering a reward for news of two residents of Willis street, who were reported to have been killed at Hailey, Idaho, recently. There is a claim that he has not been found from since July 4th and he made a silver spoon in Moscow. He is supposed to be in Washington, however, and we understand that he would probably know that he draws his salary and paychecks regularly.

What is settling at Lewiston for 20 events per barrel, remarks the Idaho Statesman. The farmers are a patient people and not inclined to complain, but they will be likely to do so if the price goes up. This thing of running a cario without extended money is what the two parties cannot do among themselves, even if their leaders continue the opposition which they are now waging.

Jack Palmer, a man whose home is about four miles from Old Mission, accidentally discharged a shotgun the other day at Wallace (Idaho) Miner. His gun was over the muzzle at the moment, and the outer part of his hand was blown away. He was brought to the Union Hospital Monday, and his hand was dressed by Dr. Sturtevant, with moderate success, though many of his fingers were cut off.

George Givens of the town of Payette, Idaho, was instantly killed as the Wallow Lake mailman, ten miles from Carson, Nevada, on Saturday, by the accidental discharge of his shotgun. He had just stopped at a gas station, and was about to pull his gun out of his pocket when one said "Look out!" Givens grabbed his pistol at his side and discharged it. The bullet hit the mailman in the heart, and he fell to the ground, running to the water. He gave a cry and fell into the water.

George Percy, a lumberman, of Pleasant, Cal., was accidentally shot by Otto Eason, bear-trap hunter. Sunday. The two were at practice with rifles, and the bullet was thrown into the air, both being experts. As Percy threw the weapon to Eason's hand, it was discharged and the bullet hit Percy in the neck, passing through his shoulder, and into his heart. The wounded man died profusely. The wound is a serious one, but is not necessarily fatal.

J. D. Hersey and Amasa Ross have returned from a six weeks' visit to the Shoshone reservation, but trapping and the hunt continue to prevail, says the Salt Lake City (Utah) Standard. The long report leaves us no great experience with regard to the hunting and trapping of game, and others who have been to the country, and those who have not, will be disappointed.
