District Court.

The September term of the Third District Court commenced to-day. Chief Justice Hunter presiding. Varrie of Grand Jury returned, but empaneling postponed till to-morrow at 10 a. m. De Norand Griffin et al, vs Morris Goldberg et al; parties plaintiff substituted. Moses Brunson vs John Gillespie, et al; habeas corpus heard on return of respondent. Passed. Samuel Kahn vs Central S. Company et al; defendant allowed, by consent, to fill supplemental answer, without plaintiff waiving right to demur. J. G. Sutherland administrator, vs John Spriggs et al; verbal report of referee made and approved. Charles Briggs vs Jesse W. Smith; motion to dismiss appeal argued. Court holds that there is no statutory appeal, denies motion to dismiss and strikes pretended appeal from docket. Moroni R. Williams vs I. E. Holden; case dismissed.

The Immigrants.

The company of immigrating Saints, in charge of Elder James Finlayson, reached here last evening according to announcement, and were met at the depot by their friends with vehicles and conveyed to their various destinations. Those who had no acquaintances, were cared for at the Emigrant House, where refreshments had been provided for their benefit. The company had a prosperous voyage. A birth occurred on the ocean and a death, that of Sarah Rockhall, aged 38, took place at Granger, on Tuesday night. With these exceptions, and the leaving of a few of its members in New York, the company arrived about the same as it left Liverpool.

The Trip.

The trip was a very quick one, leaving Liverpool at three p. m. on Sept. 2nd, the company reaching Ogden at 12.30 on the 21st, making a little less than 18 days. The child born two days before reaching New York, was named Wyoming, and the mother and babe were brought through in safety. Elder Z. P. Terry remained in New York for a short time. Elder Thomas D. Reese, who was released on account of sickness, arrived very much improved. Elder Finlayson, who has shown great prudence in his care of the company, which numbered 845 on reaching Ogden, says the trip was a splendid one. He leaves for Payson to-morrow.

The Bicycle Race at Calder's.

The bicycle race at Spring Lake Pleasure Grounds, yesterday, was a success, and the programme carried out to the letter, excepting a few minutes detention on account of the absence of one of the Judges. Although on account of the dust-storm early in the afternoon, some intending excursionists remained at home, still a goodly number were present. The wind which had been blowing a gale from the south veered to the west and fell to a pleasant breeze just before the start. The spectators gathered on the grounds near the track. The racers stripped for the contest, the three Judges and the timer took their stations, and music arose from Olsen's silver band and floated on in delightful cadence over the placid boom of the lake, as the two young athletes wheeled up to the line and Captain Davis gave the word "Go." There were about a dozen bicycles on the ground half of whom had ridden down on their wheels. Of these, five had entered for the mile race, but for various reasons only two started, viz. Mr. James Jennings and Mr. Thomas A. Williams. In the toss for position Mr. Jennings got the pole and almost from the start gradually drew away from his competitor, passing the stand on the eighth lap in 3.44, with Mr. Williams about six seconds behind. This may be considered extraordinary time for amateurs, considering the size and condition of the track and the fact that both rode roadsters instead of racers and without proper training for the race.

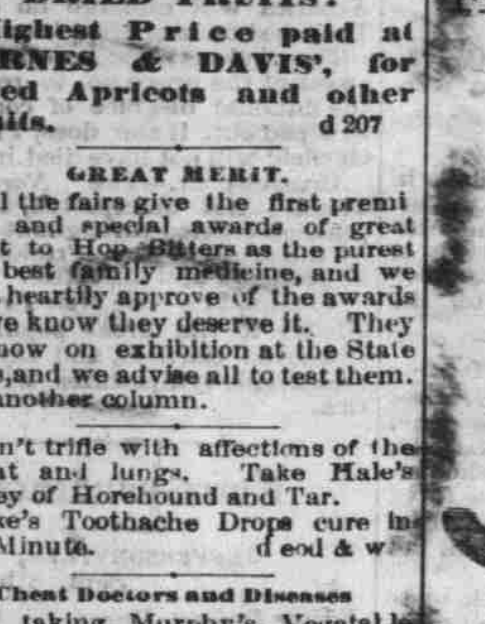
