Seriously Sick.—From U. C. Conductor John Abbott we learn that this morning, Bishop George Halliday, of Santa Clara, was in a very dangerous condition. He had been troubled a long time with a bad rupture, which, a short time since, developed into a strangulated hernia. Dr. Pike was called and performed an operation on him, but before he reached there the final trouble had existed four days, rendering the case a very difficult one. This morning instead of any improvement in his condition being apparent, he was evidently sinking, and all hopes of his recovery were not strong.

Going to Indianapolis.—Mr. H. C. Fryer is now on his last piece of work of importance at the Salt Lake Theatre—the new drop curtain. It will represent an ancient Grecian scene, and will afford splendid scope for the marked skill of the artist.

Mr. Fryer's engagement with the Salt Lake Theatre management will close before the end of the present month. From here he will go to Indianapolis, where he is due on the 1st of September. He is a thirty-two degree mason and belongs to the Indianapolis consistory. The lodge have built a new hall, which is designed to be the finest of the kind in the world, and will be in form somewhat like a theatre, with a proscenium 22 feet wide and 28 feet high. The stage will be raised only two feet from the floor, with steps leading to it. There will be two galleries of horse-shoe shape. The performances will be executed on the stage and the main floor, while the visiting brethren will occupy the galleries. The scenes will be on drop 25 feet high, requiring a height from floor to rigging between greater than that of the Salt Lake Theatre. The subjects of the scenes will be of the highest description and Mr. Fryer has received instructions to spare neither expense, labor nor any other means to give them as high a degree of excellence as can be attained.

AN IMPORTANT SUBJECT.

SOMETHING ABOUT LOCAL INSURANCE INCORPORATIONS.

Of late, in what we believed to be the interest of the public weal, we made reference to a certain local Fire Insurance Company. To-day, in conversation with Judge Merritt, a leading lawyer of this city, the subject of insurance incorporations was introduced, when that gentleman gave it his impression that an enterprise of that nature would not be a safe institution from a legal standpoint. Reference was made to Section 1839, of the Revised Statutes of the United States, which reads as follows:

Sec. 1839. The legislative assemblies of the several states shall not grant private charters or special privileges, but they may, by general incorporation acts, permit persons to associate themselves together as bodies corporate for manufacturing, or other industrial pursuits, or the construction or operation of railroads, wagon-roads, irrigating ditches, and the colonization and improvement of lands in connection therewith, or for colleges, seminaries, churches, libraries, or any benevolent, charitable or scientific association.

The Legislature of Utah passed a law, approved in 1870, in conformity with that enacted by Congress, almost following its language, of which we herewith give the first section:

"That hereafter, whenever any number of persons not less than six, one-third of whom being residents of this Territory, are desirous of associating themselves together for establishing and conducting any mining, manufacturing, commercial, or other industrial pursuit, or the construction or operation of wagon roads, irrigating ditches, or the colonization and improvement of lands, or for colleges, seminaries, churches, libraries, or any benevolent, charitable or scientific association, or for any rightful subjects consistent with the constitution of the United States and the laws of this Territory, and who wish to incorporate for that purpose, may, by complying with the provisions of this act, become a body corporate.

There is a question whether insurance could be properly included within the meaning of the terms specified in the language of either or both of the laws above quoted, and to say the least the construction of the law would put upon it a somewhat early and in doubt, giving the embarkment in an enterprise of that character an element of legal insecurity, regarding which capital is always exceedingly sensitive.

The Truly Courageous.—Young men have as a rule a powerful repugnance to being considered cowardly. This feeling arises from the fear of ridicule leading many youths naturally well disposed into the practice of wrong. There are instances of that kind in our community. They become associated with persons of their own age who are addicted to bad habits. They are invited to participate in similar indulgences, but knowing them to be wrong, hesitate. They are taunted with being afraid, and are ridiculed as being particular and puritanical, give way and step onto the path that leads downward.

If the youth who has thus been lured aside from his own honest convictions would reflect a moment, he would see that instead of acting the part of a brave boy he has exhibited the traits of a pronounced moral coward. A person may be brave even to temerity in exposing himself to physical danger at the cannon's mouth or under other trying circumstances, and yet be, so far as valor in its highest phase is concerned, an unmitigated craven. Moral bravery is elevated above mere physical valor as the spirit is above the body. The truly courageous are those who stand by their convictions at all hazards, even at the risk of reputation and worldly prospects. The youth who exhibits this noble trait and can say and act "no" when truth and morality demand it, exhibits one of the greatest qualities of manhood, and in keeping on that course will win the esteem of the good and the respect of those who are not well disposed.

Young men, do not be enticed from your honest convictions of right because of a lack of courage to stand by them. Every properly constituted man necessarily has moral convictions, and it is only the poltroon and coward who will recede from them because of the fear of ridicule or the taunts of their scurrilous associates, who should be shunned, or at least rebuked by your superior example.

Marine Bicycle.—An account was recently published in our telegrams of a bicycle ride across the British Channel, from Dover to Calais. With an ordinary bicycle this would manifestly be impossible. The rider propelled himself on what is termed a marine bicycle—i.e. two narrow racing shells bridged together side by side, supporting a light framework of iron, resembling the upper half of an ordinary bicycle, saddle, cranks, etc., complete, except that the power is communicated to a small screw propeller in the rear. The steering is done by the rudder, which is attached to the handle. Marine bicycles make fast time, and are sometimes ridden in stormy waters.

Mutual Aid.—Brother C. R. Savage is developing in his mind an idea for the establishment of a mutual aid society, the object of which would be to extend assistance to any of its members meeting with misfortune, involving the extension to them of a helping hand, providing the catastrophe is not the result of personal misconduct or carelessness. The idea of co-operative and mutual assistance in time of necessity is in harmony with the theory of the brotherhood of humanity, and whatever tends to bind the people together in a union of interests is necessarily beneficial when carefully and judiciously manipulated.

Summit County Carried.—Summit County, which was left off the list of localities where there was anything like a contest, was carried by the People's Party, on Monday by a majority of over one hundred votes.

The Manti Temple.—Brother W. H. Folger, architect and general superintendent of the Manti Temple is in town. We learn from him that the splendid structure will be roofed in this fall. The parapet will be ten feet, at the highest points, above the square of the roof, to which the walls are now up. The tower on the east end is now fourteen feet, and the west end six feet above the square of the building. At the corners of the east end there will be octagons and of the east square. The structure already has in the eyes of all visitors, a very majestic appearance, its novel site adding to its grandeur.

There are now sixty hands employed on the building, besides about fifteen at the temple saw mill, at which the lumber is cut. There is now on hand at the structure 500,000 feet of lumber.

The Temple will have a metal roof with copper gutters, and be finished off in the most excellent style in every respect.
