LONDON, 29, 10 a.m.—The manager of the North British Railway, telegraphing from Leuchars, a station on the Edinburgh and Dundee Railway, at 4 o'clock this morning, says: Several large girders along with the last train from Edinburgh were precipitated into the river last night.

A dispatch from Edinburgh dated 4 this morning says: A portion of the bridge which fell consisted of several large superincumbent girders at the central and navigable portion of the river, which averages from 40 to 45 feet in depth.

A dispatch from Dundee asserts that the number of lives lost by the Tay Bridge disaster does not exceed ninety. The bodies of six victims have been recovered.
