By request, I make you this proposition: If you will have deposited in some bank in Cheyenne, subject to my order upon judgment of a properly organized committee, \$25,000, I will assure you ten inches of rain over your said county in the months named of this year, which is more than the records show to have ever fallen; and further, I will agree that a good general rain shall fall over said area within one week after notice to me of such requirement, provided such rain is not so late as to cause any failure on my part to work for the benefit of said proposed district.
