SUGAR BEETS. Boulder County Farmers Will Try Raising Them This Year.

In accordance with the announcement Messrs. Pierce and Austin held meetings in Willard, Three Mile Creek and Brigham, Tuesday. The meetings were very well attended, there was talk to the point, questions and answers, those in attendance showing much interest in the proposition. In brief, the owners of the proposed Ogden sugar factory agree to pay the Boulder county farmers \$4 a ton for the sugar beets at the factory; the railroad has made a rate of 25 cents a ton for the beets; the factory will require 150 tons of beets at 15 cents per pound in new and old beets. This should be a net profit of 10 to 15 cents in the acre. The Ogden sugar factory will have a capacity of receiving 100 tons of beets per day, as there is not much chance to fear an overcrop, as the production of beets is not a very certain thing. As to the sugar market, the price is very low, and the factory will be able to handle a large quantity of beets each year.

In all three years contracts were entered for raising many acres of beets—Brigham leader.
