

was still able to largely import munitions of war from America, although it professed its inability to relieve the Rhodope refugees.

Stanhope, under secretary for India, moved a resolution that the consent of the House be given to the defrayal of the Afghan war expenses from Indian revenues. He said government hoped and believed the war would remain a mere frontier war.

Fawcett moved an amendment to the effect that the proposal was unjust.

Gladstone seconded the amendment, declaring the proposal invited the House to entirely abdicate its control over the direction of the war.

After several minor speeches, Sir Stafford Northcote declared it was not intended to charge the whole mill any expenditures on India.

The debate was adjourned. Public mourning for the Grand Duchess of Hesse will last three weeks, and the court will remain in mourning six weeks.

The Times says: The introduction and withdrawal of the motion for granting aid to the sufferers in the Rhodope District becomes very simple when the reasons are stated that it was thought by ministers the distress revealed by the report of the Rhodope commission was a fitting object for parliamentary aid, but it would have been indecorous to make an act of charity the occasion of a heated debate, and the purpose of government was no sooner known than it was clear that it would be resisted on both sides of the house.

A correspondent with the Khurum column reports that a predatory tribe attacked, on Sunday, the rear guard of the convoy east of the Sapieri Pass. Gen. Roberts sent two regiments, which rescued the convoy. Two British officers were severely wounded, three Ghoorkas were killed and 12 Ghoorkas and one Highlander wounded.

Gen. Roberts has summoned the Chief of Kurum to answer for the outrage. It is feared that three powerful tribes will combine against the British.

The report of the investigating committee on the West of England and South Wales District Bank shows that the whole capital and reserve funds have been lost, and there is a further deficiency of £1,500,000, for which the shareholders are liable. There is no possibility of a reconstruction of the bank.

FRANKFORT-ON-THE-MAIN, 17.—Karl Ferdinand Gutschow, German dramatic poet, is dead.

PESTH, 17.—The Hungarian delegation have agreed to the Austrian delegation amendments, to the estimates for striking out grants for ironclads and for increasing the number of army officers.

CONSTANTINOPLE, 17.—The Porte and Great Britain are negotiating concerning British jurisdiction over foreigners in Cyprus. Great Britain recognizes the Sultan's sovereignty over the island, but denies that capitulation concerning the consular jurisdiction is still applicable there.
