NEWS OF THE WEST.
Lockjaw Caused by a Boy's Fall From a Tree.
BABY DROWNED IN A TUB.
Tramp's Car's Tightly Bolted—Lighting a City Free—Killed by a Runaway.

A committee of 100 has been organized by the citizens of Butte, Montana, to rid the city of lawless characters.
The Pacific, a Cal., electric railway has increased its light, the city streets free of charge, which means a saving to the city of \$11,000 per annum.

H. St. Paulsen, a wealthy wine dealer of New Orleans, who was injured on May 19th as the result of jumping from a balcony while the team clinched it, is now on his way, discharging at St. Helena, Cal. The team was injured and killed by a runaway.

Friday evening the one-year-old child of W. O. Covett, a farmer living near Mendocino, Cal., was drowned in a wash tub. The baby was playing in the tub and the mother, who was washing clothes, was not watching him. The child was found floating in the water, dead.

Saturday afternoon James Hyde of Sacramento, Cal., fell from his wagon while driving in front of the county hospital. The wheel of the wagon, which is a four-horse affair, and quite heavy, passed over his body, fracturing several ribs and breaking one shoulder. Hyde died a very few minutes after the fall.

Glenn Arrighio, who on January 9th shot and killed his elder brother at Truckee, Cal., was found guilty of manslaughter Saturday afternoon in trial all week. The defendant admitted the shooting, but claimed in extenuation that he had taken thirty grains of quinine that day, and the effect of the drug was to make him think his brother was a tramp about to attack him.

A farmer named Morris was shot from ambush while working at his house in the timber, a few miles from Elgin, Oregon, on Saturday. The ball passed through the lower part of the body, near the groin, and it is not thought Morris will live. Petty larceny had been going on in that section and an arrest had been made at the instance of Morris. This, it is supposed, caused the shooting.

Willie Hamon, the twelve-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. W. J. Hamon, of Sacramento, Cal., died Saturday at Lockjaw. One day last week the boy fell from a tree at East Park, where he was searching for bird's nests and broke both arms. One arm was so badly shattered that it was thought amputation would be necessary, but the boy was attacked by lockjaw last night and died this morning.
