

DEVELOPMENTS IN AUTO SITUATION

Sensational Features Brought
About by Vanderbilt Cup
Commission.

CONDITIONS NOT CHANGED.

Big Event May Be Blacklisted by In-
ternational Association of Recog-
nized Automobile Clubs.

New York, May 21.—There have been several sensational developments in the international automobile racing situation on this side of the Atlantic. These include a refusal of the Vanderbilt Cup commission to change its conditions to conform to the rules of the Ogdenville commission, the sending out of an elaborate press sheet that was not authorized by the Automobile Club of America in which it was stated that the club planned the promotion of an international race at Savannah, Ga. an outspoken demand on the part of importers of automobiles that in the premises it is the date of the Automobile Club of America to promote a race under international rules and finally, an intimation that the Vanderbilt Cup race may be blacklisted by the International Association of recognized automobile clubs.

Jefferson Thompson, chairman of the Vanderbilt Cup commission, in a letter to Robert Lee Morrell, chairman of the Ogdenville commission, in the receipt of the latter's letter enclosing the protest of the Automobile Club of America, recited the fact that the subject of rules had been carefully discussed two months ago, declared that there is no possibility of any change being made in the Vanderbilt conditions. The press sheet that was disseminated by importers in a dispatch from Savannah, that recounted how S. M. Butler, president of the club, had visited that city on Saturday last and made a proposition to the Savannah Automobile club to promote an international race in Savannah in November. It was learned later that Mr. Butler had been in that city Saturday. It was denied, however, that he had made a proposition for a club race there.

FORT DOUGLAS TEAM MAY JOIN LEAGUE

There was another meeting at the Kenyon last evening of those interested in baseball and who are determined to see a league organized here so that Salt Lake fans may witness the national game. It is now quite certain that Fort Douglas will not be in the proposed league and there seems no chance whatever of Logan putting in a team.

At last evening's meeting a plan was suggested whereby Fort Douglas will put in a team. Lieut. Elliott was at the meeting and stated that the soldiers could put in a team and a good one. Accordingly a franchise for them was granted. It is the plan of Lieut. Elliott to gather up some of the best players in the army, secure uniforms for them and bring them to Salt Lake for the season. It might be necessary to get some players who are not soldiers but there would be no objection to this. The Fort team is not required to put up the \$1,000 fee but will not be guaranteed anything for expenses. Instead it will receive one-quarter of the pooled gate receipts.

There will be meetings at Ogdenville and Murray this evening and the plans will be submitted to those behind the movement in the two towns. If the scheme goes through, and there is apparently no reason why it should not, the league will be composed of Salt Lake, Ogdenville, Murray and Fort Douglas. Those present at last evening's meeting were: Ed Gimlin and F. N. Bosner of Ogdenville, J. C. Smith of Murray, and H. O. Boyd, A. G. Mackenzie, John C. Tobin and W. E. Shoppe of Salt Lake.
