WILSON SUES BECK CREDITORS Demands an Accounting of the Transactions With Beck.

THE RELIEF HE PAYS FOR.

Asks that the 51,000 Shares of Bullion-Beck Stock to Cunningham be Adjudged Void.

There has been another turn in the affairs of John Beck involuntary bankrupt and before the proceedings end it may change the aspect of Beck's case entirely.

Trustee Wilson's complaint sets out that the secured claims against Beck which were put into Trustee Barnett's hands for liquidation out of the assets assigned did not exceed \$25,000.

The trustee alleges that in order to prevent one Sarah Everhard from getting execution against the equity of redemption in Beck's \$1,000 shares of Bullion-Beck mining stock, which was in the hands of Joseph Barnett as trustee, to satisfy her judgment against Beck of \$5,241, Beck induced Cunningham to advance enough money to satisfy Mrs. Everhard's claim.

Trustee Wilson also avers on information and belief that Beck and Cunningham, with intent to hinder, delay and defraud Beck's unsecured creditors, entered into an agreement whereby Cunningham took a bill of sale absolute on its face for the 51,000 shares of Bullion-Beck stock.

For equitable relief for Beck's unsecured creditors, Trustee Wilson sets out other alleged acts of fraud by Cunningham and Beck, and prays for an accounting of all debts secured by the syndicate trust and the amounts paid from stock dividends for purchase of mortgages and otherwise to liquidate the claims; that the transfer of Beck's 51,000 shares of Bullion-Beck stock to Cunningham be adjudged void and the right of possession thereof be awarded to plaintiff in trust for all of Beck's creditors, and that Trustee Barnett be also required to deliver to plaintiff the Indian Creek mining shares.

Reeves & Schroeder and Brown & Henderson are Trustee Wilson's attorneys.
