Schirmer, director of the Bos-ton Con., upon his return to Boston a few days ago, after having visited this state, is gloted as saying: "I was informed by our engineers that within 90 days we should be able to furnish our new mill with at least 2,000 tons of ore a day. The mill is showing a recovery of 70% per cent from our porphyry ores, which we con-sider satisfactory. At times the recov-ery has been as high as 75 per cent. Our ores have averaged 1% per cent copper, which is also satisfactory. "The frouble has been that our ores, taken from the top of the mountain, where it was deemed advisable to start the steam shovel work, have shown a higher percentage of iron than was originally figured upon, and iron in too great a quantity is usdesirable, as it inflicts penalities from the smelters, adds to our cost and reduces the con-centration.
