

Sunday School Union.

PROVO.

An Alleged Embodiment Case.—Court Items—Dumped in a Ditch—Other Matters.

Regular Correspondence.

PROVO, May 17.—In the district court yesterday the jury in the case of William Hartley Jr. vs Caroline Holdaway et al. returned a verdict of \$25 for plaintiff against Caroline Holdaway, and no cause of action against the other defendant.

The next case for trial before Judge Smith was one of unusual interest. The title of the case is Provo Co-operative Institution vs Thomas Hardling. This suit is brought to recover \$1,000, the amount alleged to have been embezzled by defendant while in the employ of the Provo Co-op. Hardling was convicted a short time since in a justice's court of embezzeling \$25, which case is now pending on appeal.

Evidence substantially the same as that given in the criminal case was given in the present case. David John, a co-operative clerk, stated that during the two weeks prior to the date of the submittal of the \$2 marked coins had every day been placed in the cash register and a small change given. A count in the safe was made monthly, and during the week \$20 had disappeared without being accounted for. The indications were strong that Hard-

ling had taken this money. Evidence was most introduced to show that Hardling's salary as clerk had been \$200 per month, and it was shown that during the three years he had kept his daughter's name over \$200, so that he had expended in various ways (not all of them found quite legitimate) at the approximate rate of \$10 per month. It was also shown that he was in the habit of changing small silver for gold and banking the gold. Hardling was placed on the stand to defend himself, in relation to others his memory failed to serve him and in other instances he answered the questions of the attorneys in an evasive manner. In one instance he said he had earned the money by working in the Woods Mills. The defendant has filed a counter claim of \$20 for wages due him by the institution. The case was submitted to the jury this morning.

Suit has been filed by the Fairview Stake, for recovery of \$200 on a note signed by Joseph C. and Hannah C. Carlson.

On a complaint sworn to by Lester McChesney, formerly of Churchill, R. Taylor, attorney for the State, charged that McChesney had been engaged in the practice of law in California, and that he had been suspended from the bar there for a period of six months. When I came here I found him still at law with all his old clients.
