Gold Strikes in Provo Canon.

The prospectors of Wednesday announce that a rich strike of gold has been made in Provo Canon, that a district to be known as the Lulu Mining District has already been organized, and several claims recorded. The location is thus described:

For some months past prospecting has been going on quietly in the South Fork of Provo Canon, and also in the canon proper, just opposite the South Fork, on the north side of the river. In fact, prospectors have been in the immediate neighborhood, and on the 15th of the month past, being convinced that there was mineral in the indications. But until very recently no definite ledge or true veins could be found. At last, however, the main ledge was discovered from which the "float" had come, and can now be traced for several miles, running a little east of north and west of south. The ledge seems to be an extension of the Cottonwood and Parley's Park mines, and is probably a part of the mineral belt that extends to Mt. Nebo, Mary's Vale, Frisco and Reef. The most noted location on the ledge at present is the Lulu mine, from which has been taken very rich ore.

A survey of the district will be made this week and a town laid out. The prospects are said to be so promising that ere long the Lulu mines will become as notorious as any in the country.

Amusing Runaway.—About 4 o'clock Tuesday afternoon, an amusing runaway took place in the neighborhood of the Penitentiary. A man left his team standing near there, containing four hogs and a calf, and while he was absent a few moments, the youthful boy, jumped over the front gate of the wagon, upon the horse's back, causing them to become frightened and start off at a terrible rate down the hill. The calf fell down between the two animals and its rope getting caught it was hurried swiftly but safely along, while the pigs, thinking the day of judgment had come at last, set up an unearthly squealing, and began dancing an Irish jig all over the wagon. Turning the corner by the Deseret Paper Mill, the moving menagerie tore down the road in true classic style, so that when the astonished driver reached the mill corner with barely enough breath to ejaculate, "Where are they?" the objects to which he doubtless had reference had blended beautifully with that element which is said to lend enchantment to the view. The career of the escapades was terminated a mile or two below, when it was found that no injury had been done any party to the transaction.
