UNDERWRITERS AT BANQUET

Legislation Needed in Insurance Circles is Discussed.

The Utah Association of Life Underwriters held its fourth annual banque Saturday night, when it was decided

to ask the legislature for a codification of the insurance laws, increasing the rights of the state to control all the insurance of the state by the appointment of a commissioner of insurance, the creation of an insurance depart-ment in the state, and a continuance of the tax of $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the gross premium collected upon the insurance now written within the state, a law which is now in force.

A letter was read from President, Edwards of the National Association of Life Underwriters advising the re-moval of any taxation upon life pre-miums. The banquet was largely at-rended, and among the speakers were: Governor Spry on the "Necessity of New Insurance Legislation," "Insurance Mituriton," Colonal Genera, P. Senated New Insurance Legislation, "Insurance Situation," Colonel George B. Squries; "Uniform Laws," E. C. Ashton, and some informal remarks by Mayne John S. Bransford, Judge W. H. King was toastmaster.
