The fluid struck the young lady, passing over most of the surface of her body, knocking her almost insensible, and blistering her severely on several parts of her person. The electric current then tore a strip from the clock shelf, traveled over the face of a large picture, breaking pieces from the frame, then made its exit, leaving the inmates of the house more dead than alive. Mrs. Holst has about recovered, and the young lady is gradually recovering from the shock and injuries received from her terrible visitor.
