The Real Estate Exchange Endorses the Tabernacle Choir Enterprise.

There were several suggestions, including one to give the exchange a proportionate amount of advertising in salt lake, if the exchange would aid in securing advertising. The special committee to arrange for an excursion to Salt Lake by the exchange reported that arrangements had been made for Tuesday, June 27. The committee have in charge of preparing an elaborate program.

The communication from H. G. Whiting asking the exchange to aid in the enterprise of having the Tabernacle choir visit the World's Fair, was considered.

On motion of J. T. Lynch the business was adjourned until the 1st of June at 8 o'clock of the exchange, and the secretary, instructed to furnish a copy of the minutes to the committee in charge of the Tabernacle choir, extension to Chicago.

The company holds gas lands as follows: In Salt Lake county, 2871 acres; Tooele county, 500 acres; Box Elder county, 4277 acres; Weber county, 50 acres. Total, 3828 acres.
