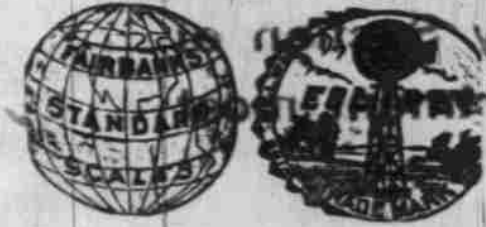

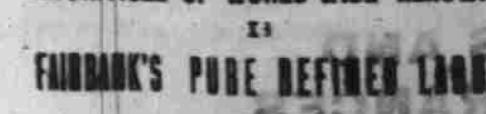

CAPITAL NEWS.

WASHINGTON, 21.—At a meeting, afternoon, of the Spanish-American Club, Count Lowenhaupt, umpire, rendered a decision in the case of Jose M. Macias, an ex-convict, who had been deported from the United States, who claimed from the Spanish government damages to the amount of \$500,000, principle and interest for losses caused by the capture of his ship, the "Mariano," in 1878. The United States citizenship was admitted, as were the general facts of the case, under the provisions of the act of March 3, 1878, but the claimant principle and interest amounting to \$250,000.

The letter of Durant, upon naturalization questions raised in a former decision, will be submitted to Count Lowenhaupt on Monday, when it is understood it will be made public.

Treasury Matters.
At the conclusion of business, today, notices had been received at the treasury department for continuation, \$200,000,000 of five per cent. bonds. In most instances the bonds are already received at the department. It is thought the limit of \$250,000,000 registered as, which can be converted into 30 per cent, will be reached Monday. A large number of telegrams were received today, inquiring if 6 per cent. bonds would be accepted for conversion into 30 per cent. bonds.

The following reply was telegraphed in each instance:

Receipt received for presentation of bonds for conversion. The bonds are accepted and request cannot be granted.

Early Saturday morning next, the treasury officials say that all the \$500,000,000 of five per cent. bonds will have been received at the department.

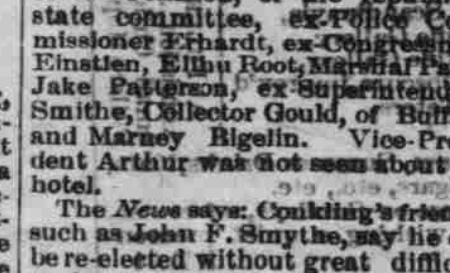

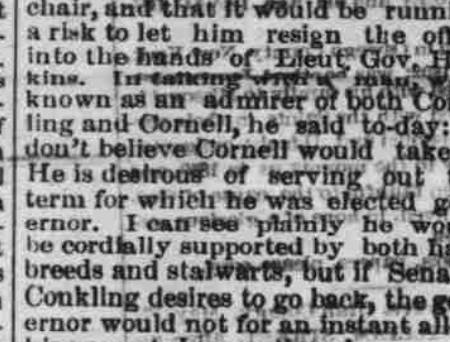

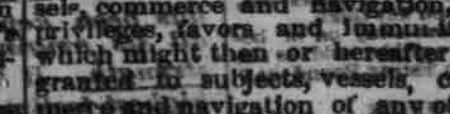
