

PALMA TAKES RADICAL ACTION

Issues Decree Suspending Constitutional Guarantees in Three Provinces.

Members of Veterans' Peace Commission Almost Unanimously Denounced the President.

Havana, Sept. 10.—President Palma has issued a decree suspending all constitutional guarantees, with special reference to articles 15, 16, 17, 19, 22, 23, 24, 25 and 27, in the provinces of Pinar del Rio, Havana and Santa Clara.
