The Eastern Question—England's Position.

LONDON, 2.—The anti-Russian sentiment has unquestionably developed largely here this week. While the situation looks somewhat more critical and more like a possible extension of the war and England's participation therein, there is still little real reason for apprehension. England is demonstrating to force Russia to show her hand. The probabilities are that Russia will not close the peace negotiations without the approval of its terms by the powers. This is quite true. However Russia consistently maintains that her position is one of agreement with Turkey are provisional only. This means that they will not be considered final
