New York, Sept. 28.—A special to the Herald from Washington says: An official announcement of the departure of the Japanese cruiser Naniwa for Honolulu, together with the news that the immigration question is being handled by the Japanese government, has thrown a peaceful aspect upon the Hawaiian situation. It is now believed that the Japanese government will be satisfied with the \$50,000 damages which have been promised to the state department by minister Boreau, stationed at Honolulu, who has just returned.
