



SITE OF THE GREAT STRAWBERRY VALLEY RESERVOIR. Whose Area Will Cover a Vast Section and Whose Waters Will Irrigate Thousands of Acres in Utah County.

The above view is that of the site of the proposed Strawberry valley reservoir dam which will extend across between the declivates at the right and left of the picture, the vista beyond being the basin of what is to be a great lake. The reservoir will hold 190,000 acre feet, or 5,000 acres, with a depth of 50 feet. The location of the tunnel through the divide is four miles in the distance across the valley, and the water will be raised to the level of the tunners mouth. The government engineers are busy prospecting the soils for exact location of the dam, and will soon be in readiness to start con-
