THE city is full of rumors respecting the action of the court, the law officer appointed by the court and the Grand Jury. The violation of law in the selection of a Grand Jury, the pains which were taken to exclude men from that Jury who did not suit the prosecuting attorney and the Judge, followed by the charge of the latter personage, have prepared men's minds for proceedings of a vindictive character on the part of officials. There are other reasons, also, which the public have been freely made that a noted desperado, recently arrested on the charge of murder, was ready to divulge his crimes and to implicate prominent citizens as his accomplices. This man has been seen walking and conversing cheek by jowl, as though with some companions, with officials who have reason to believe are pledged to do all in their power to destroy the leading citizens of this community, and this, too, when the published statements of the members of the "ring" describe him as a self-confessed murderer. When such a man is seen in such company it excites suspicion, especially when it is known that he has been before the Grand Jury. The people suspect that he is a suborned witness. Are they not warranted in entertaining this suspicion? By his own reported confession, his life is forfeit to the law, and who knows that the greatest earthly inducement that can be presented to a man of his stripe may not be offered to him, if his testimony be only the kind that is desired? Besides it is said that for two weeks previous to the meeting of the Grand Jury he boasted of what he intended to do. Rumors on the street state that he has given testimony upon which indictments have been issued against prominent citizens. They are so often repeated that we are almost inclined to think there is some foundation for them. If so, this becomes a grave matter. The lives and liberties of gentlemen who enjoy the entire confidence of the community are to be imperilled by the testimony of a desperado who stands self-convicted of the repeated commission of the highest crime known to the laws.

The slanderous assertions which have been published by the members of the "ring" respecting this man's testimony are all the accused and the people of the country will bear. They have endured so many of these accusations and outlived them that they treat them with the silent contempt which they deserve, considering it too great a condescension even to deny them. But when they are listened to and entertained by a Grand Jury, they assume a different shape. When indictments are issued upon them, they become official and tangible, and can be met without sacrifice of dignity. The "ring" will find that the citizens of Utah have no disposition to shrink from the investigation of the worst and blackest charges which have been circulated against them, even before the highest or most public tribunal in the land. Rather than shrink from such an investigation they would welcome it as a desirable opportunity of vindicating themselves in the eyes of the world, and making public their true characters.

If the rumors to which we allude be true, and this desperado has given testimony before the Grand Jury against men of worth in this community, we demand in the name of the people, whose sentiments we know we utter, that he must not be allowed to escape. Let it not be said when he is wanted that he ran away, or suddenly disappeared and is not, therefore, forthcoming. He is now in the custody of the officers of the court; they can keep him safely, and let them look to it that he shall be forthcoming to repeat in public court the testimony which he gave to the Grand Jury, that the world may know the nature of the evidence and the character of the witness upon which charges are made against the leading citizens of Utah.

IN CONSEQUENCE of the persistent slanders of prejudiced, malicious, or interested individuals, many people in the east believe, at the least they profess to believe, that the citizens of this Territory, and especially the more prominent citizens, are a disorderly, law-defying, traitorous people, whereas, those who know the facts, know that a more peaceably disposed, orderly, law-abiding people do not exist in the broad expanse of the whole Union, nor in the whole world. We say this advisedly, and largely from personal knowledge.

This is not the only place we have lived in, by a large number, and, not taking the "outside element" into account, it is our testimony that in no other community, so far as our experience goes, is there less profanity than in this, in no other community there are less drunkenness, in no other community there is less disposition to kill than in this, in no other community there is less readiness to settle all difficulties amicably, in no other community there has been less litigation than in this, in no other community there has been less proportion of difficulties settled by peaceful and neighborly arbitration, in no other border community has there been less stealing, less violence, fewer murders, fewer oppositions to the course of good and wholesome laws. These are assertions which our experience teaches us are true, but at the same time we by no means assert that our citizens have no imperfections, for we are often painfully sensible of the contrary.

How then is it that grave charges are frequently preferred and bruited around against prominent members of the community and against the community in general? Because it is a very easy thing for apostates and other desperados to make reckless charges. Whether the people of the United States at large know it or not, there is a large element in the population of this Union that is as corrupt as hell could make it, and this corrupt element stops at nothing to accomplish its hellish purposes—it invades all departments, but especially the political and

the social. Officers do not escape its gangrenous touch—in the civil and judicial departments its presence is remarkably manifest, for proof of which see the current condition of New York and other cities, to say nothing of the outrageous course of officials frequently in more remote parts of the country.

As a rule, the vile charges made against prominent members of this community and against the community itself, are made by individuals who are well known to be bankrupt in character, and whose words, as they color them, would not be believed on oath by any person who knows them intimately. We could name several individuals, who are given to this nefarious work of slander, and who, in their past course, have perfectly played themselves out among those by whom they are known. If you ask what is thought of a character of that description by his acquaintance, it will be answered, "Oh, he is a bad egg!" However, rotten eggs always were favorite arguments with people who could find no better with which to support their own case and attack those whom they were disposed to annoy and abuse.

Nothing can be done against the truth, but for it. Circumstances of an opposing nature may apparently overwhelm it temporarily, but by and by the storm subsides, the clouds disperse, the sun breaks forth as brightly as before, and the rock of truth is seen again firm and enduring as ever. It is the same with principles. There is no need of notice and new development, that was not met by storm after storm of opposition and abuse, and followed up and relentlessly pursued thereby, until it manifested that the new or newly presented principle had obtained such influence that it would no longer pay to oppose it. These is the time the abuse and the opposition cease, or become so weak and local as to be no longer worthy of notice. But at all other times the opposition and the abuse ebb and flow like the tide.

Thus it is in regard to what the world knows as "Mormonism." It is a system of needed truths, some new, some old, but which had become practically obsolete. From the beginning unmeasured opposition and abuse have met and followed and sought to overwhelm it, but in vain. Though sometimes struck at fiercely and apparently near utter destruction, yet, in one way or another, it has invariably triumphed over its enemies, and has advanced with mighty strides while they have retrograded.

Opposition to the principles of "Mormonism" now and henceforth will have the same results—the truth, though overshadowed for a time, will ultimately triumph. This is just as sure as that the sun will shine again after it sets or obscured by clouds. Storms and clouds, physical, religious, social, or political, do not endure for ever, and are only temporary and often evanescent, while the truth does and will endure unimpeded and immutable through all eternity, and the truth which it will partake of its character and share in its triumphs.

Editor Desert News:—The pure and impartial administration of justice, under whatever form of government, is perhaps the firmest bond to secure tranquility among citizens or subjects, and to engage their affections to their rulers. Hence to devise means to secure this end, has engaged the attention of the greatest statesmen the world has produced.

The trial by jury, notwithstanding its many recorded and unrecorded abuses, has been, and is very likely to remain through succeeding generations, the greatest bulwark of the rights and political liberties of the people. I do not here intend to furnish examples of the justice or injustice of verdicts delivered by juries in famous or infamous trials, but propose to examine briefly the origin and subsequent development of trial by jury, as far as my information will permit.

The word jury is derived from the Latin word *juris*, to swear, and *juris* means a body of men who are sworn to try and pass upon the truth of the issues of fact, from the evidence placed before them.

To select a judicial tribunal of several men who were sworn or had otherwise pledged themselves to administer justice according to truth in all cases of which they were to take judicial cognizance, seems to have been the custom of the most ancient nations. In ancient Egypt, the priests selected thirty judges, who were distinguished for their honesty, out of the principal cities, and the one who had the greatest reputation for wisdom was placed at their head. This great tribunal, being animated by the reverence, administered justice gratuitously throughout the whole kingdom.

We learn from Josephus, that the kings of Persia used to administer justice in their own persons, and were extremely careful to have justice rendered with integrity and impartiality. It is safe to assume, however, that on occasions when matters of importance were to be determined, they were attended by their seven counselors. Scripture in the letter of authority given by King Artaxerxes to Ezra: "Forasmuch as thou art sent of the king and his seven counselors." (Ezra vii. 14.)

Among the early Greeks, all matters of high importance were laid before the assembly of the people—a custom which seemed to prevail in Asia Minor, for when Paul was arraigned for having blasphemed the goddess Diana, in Ephesus, his disciple, Alexander, demanded to be heard in the assembly of the People. (Acts xix. 35, 41.) Homer describes a Court of Justice and lays out in the *Iliad* i. xviii. v. The elders who composed the court, were seated on polished marble benches within the sacred circle. "Before them the litigants, earnestly stepping forward, pleaded by turns, and judgment was awarded in favor of him who supported his cause by the clearest testimony and the fairest arguments. But it is worthy in the Athenian jurisprudence, as referred by Pindar, that we discover trial by jury similar to that which was adopted in the English Constitution.
