ANACT

TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED | W719 AND NINETY-ONE OF THE COM PILED LAWS OF UTAH.

Be it enacted by the Governor and Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Utah: That section one hundred and ninety-one of the Compiled Laws of Utah is hereby amended so read as follows: Section 191. The clerks of the county courts are hereby required to keep an accurate account of all receipts and expenditures of their respective counties, also of all debts payable to and by said counties.
