WASHINGTON, 16.—Speaker, chairman of the committee on military affairs, reported a resolution calling on the Secretary of War to inform the House of the number, rank, names and annual pay of every officer on the retired list of the army.

The first bill on the calendar was one returning to Charles Clinton, late Assistant Treasurer at New Orleans, the sum of \$1,000, being the amount stolen from him in 1871 and refunded by him to the United States.

A somewhat extended debate followed, confined principally to the question whether the principle should be established that no relief should be extended to any bonded officer of the government for losses sustained by him in the discharge of his official duty.
