RULES FOR MEMBERS.

With the reorganization proposed by the building committee next, we again present these general rules for the guidance of voters:

1—If you wish to stand a straight party ballot, cast your vote for the road to the right of your party emblem, and make no other mark.

2—If you wish to make any change whatever from a straight party ticket, or cast more than one straight party emblem.

3—When you do not vote a straight ticket, or cast your emblem, put a check in the box of the class of candidates you wish to vote for, and make no other mark on any ballot.

4—You do not vote directly for President and Vice-President, although the names of candidates are on the ticket, you vote for electors on the State ticket, choosing those of the party whose presidential candidates you wish to support.

By following these rules you will have no difficulty whatever in having your ballot cast as you want it to be.

THE IDAHO CASE AND AGAIN.

The "Church instruction" legation in Idaho is still being worked on, and a delegate to the B.M.L. took meeting papers from that B.M.L. Wm. Dickey and others in Church positions in Bear Lake and stated in public meetings that "the Mormons were instructed not to vote for Hayes." The News does not have the exact language the speakers referred to may have used, but they spoke on the subject of all not from a long and intimate acquaintance with the gentlemen named as one of the accused parties, nor from a knowledge of his character, the News feels free to say that he has made no such statement. Possibly he or someone else may have said, "that the Mormons were not instructed to vote for Hayes" and if he did, that is true, as far as the Church is concerned, the Mormons have not been instructed from that source for whom to vote, and will not be.

It will be observed that the transmission of new word in the sentence quoted makes all the difference in the world, all scheming politicians and rank politicians are not above making a little noise. They have done things equally as bad in the Idaho campaign that are not mentioned in Thomas' News. And whenever someone may say or claim, the News reiterates the fact that "the Mormons have not been instructed to vote for Hayes" the Mormons have not been instructed to vote for McKinley, or any other candidate, or as far as the Church instructions go, influence is concerned. Certain politicians have been "instructing" the people on either side, as the 20th states yesterday, and these politicians are a little agitated because the people reorganize those "instructions" to no longer. The Mormons will do other things, vote according to their convictions on national party issues, leaving out all questions of religion or Church membership.

In the Minsterier dispute referred to, the will to the council is referred to the closing sentence that "the administration has been settled with the Church authorities at Salt Lake." The allegation that any Church influence has been used on Church instruction gives an emphatic contradiction, but there was no response to an immediate demand for a telegraphed affidavit. A reason was that the cost of establishing such a telegram was recognized. It was that Church influence might be used in negative form in the interest of the parties making the demand, just as has been sought to do with other express premiums by both parties to the conflict. The Mormon Church, of course, is not responsible to any of the sides in the political controversy.
