WOMEN'S DEPARTMENT.  
The Contributions for Exhibition at the coming World's Fair.  
Among the exhibits last received for the women's department of the World's Fair, at the office of the Territorial board of lady managers, Constitution building, are some curious ancient relics and rare specimens of women's handwork. The contribution from Washington county includes a singular Indian water jug, manufactured of native grasses, and also a unique article of hand gear of the same material, and a piece of decorated pottery made by an Indian girl. There are a set of dishes, manufactured of Utah sulphur, and a coat of a hand of the same material from Millard county. Mrs. Pauline Lyman, of Parowan, sends some counterpane, manufactured of Utah grown cotton, spun and woven by hand. A very handsomely embroidered spread, also of hand manufacture, and made of Utah cotton, was received, and a knit spread of the same material. The ladies of Richville contribute two pillow and bed covers of hand-made work in original design, manufactured in Utah from Utah grown flax. Among the relics is a hand of salt water from St. George, said to have been dug up in 1861 by a Mr. Baldwin.
