THE JEWISH PROBLEM.

A New Year Letter from the Carina to the Princess of Wales.

London, Jan. 7.—Advice from St. Petersburg states that while the Jews are being deported from the Russian Empire, they are within the forbidden districts of the frontier, and in some instances villages are being razed to the ground.

A Jewish father has been fined because his son did not attend school, the son having been killed when an infant, many years before. The estate which the Jews are compelled to abandon are being obtained by land speculators for a mere song.
