Criminal business taken up by Judge Barich.

GRICE BURGLARY CASE SUGGESTED.

Pett Juries for the September Term—Fined for Duck Shooting—Court Actions.

Work in the criminal branch of the district court business was taken up by Judge Barich today. U. S. Attorney Judd was absent, but affairs were attended to by Assistant Royal and Bistrick. The first work of the day was the filing of the U. S. Marshal, or the following names of persons condemned on open verdict to serve as juries for the term.

Upon the fall of the jury, all responded not. James replied, Heber Johnson and Fred Tullis.

Levi Johnson was excused for the reason that he had served as a juror within the past year, to wit, in March last. Lars Johnson was excused for cause taking him from home at this time would work against his health.

Mr. Perkins was excused because of recent jury service. All others were passed, and selected in the Edmunds-Tucker case.

Pending the trial, Mr. Tullis, a attorney for the defense, filed a motion in the case of Peter A. Clark, charged with murder in the first degree. Clark had been admitted to plead this morning. His counsel asked that the argument on the defense be held to tomorrow. The prosecution declined to the postponement and insisted on the commencement and initiation of an immediate hearing.

This was ordered, and Mr. Tullis, attorney for Clark, proceeded to argue his motion, which raised the point that there are two crimes charged in the indictment, namely, an attempt to take life, and also the crime of murder, in killing Henry H. Nugent, a Park City, Summit county man, in April, 1888. The law provides that but one crime can be charged in an indictment.

Assistant U. S. Attorney Richards replied, insisting that only one crime was charged, namely, murder in the first degree, while the first part was merely a recital of the assault by which the murder was committed. This rental was essential to the validity of the indictment for murder, and did not affect a separate offense.

The indictment was in the usual form that has been followed for years in the Territory. Judge Barich read it over carefully, and then overruled the motion.

A jury was called in the case of Daniel Price, charged with burglary. The defense raised the point that the defendant had been in jeopardy before, having been convicted Oct. 1, 1888, of the same offense. The prosecution replied that the former indictment was held to be defective, hence there was no legal jeopardy. This view was taken by the court, and the trial was postponed.

The defendant Grimes was represented by J. M. Hamilton and C. W. Morris. Mr. Grimes leads his household with an infant in her arms and a boy three or four years old by her side. These constitute the defendant's family. Their clothing and general appearance indicate poverty.

Mr. Grimes is accused of having burglarized James W. Wilson's butcher shop, on the corner of Eighth West and First South streets, in this city, March 31, 1890. The prosecution claims that a knife stolen from the butcher shop, a tool fitting the marks where the door was planed off, with other stolen stolen articles, were found in his possession. Mr. Grimes' house, at, tries to show that he was not absent from home the night of the burglary. He says that the day he was found in his house, tool and other articles in his possession, and carried them to his house. It is on this circumstantial evidence that the defense hopes to explain satisfactorily to the jury, the facts, and the police officers, the circumstances and fading the articles named in Grimes' possession. Grimes and his wife testified to the defendant being at home the evening the crime was committed, and he was carrying a sack containing the stolen articles.

The case had not been concluded up to the time of going to press.
