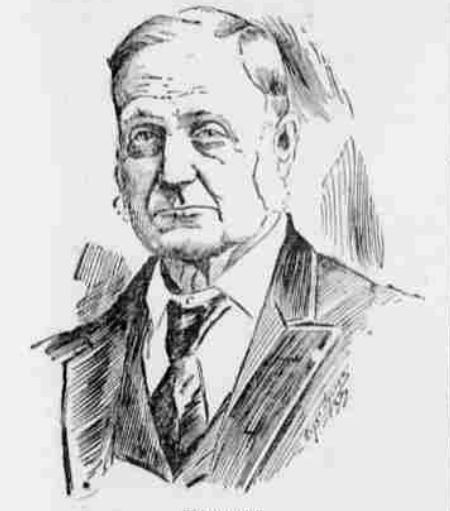

Veterans of the Black Hawk War

The subject of the exhibit, Edward Lee, was born at Chichester, England, on August 26, 1863. Came to Utah in 1884, arriving at Reynoldsville the 25th day of October, settling on in the northern part of the State the following morning in a special shipment.

In the year 1884, early in the month of February, he was called to participate in what is known as the coronado of Captain Isaac Harvey, which occurred west of the mouth of the Snake River, in Idaho.

There Henry Menden and Washington Carlson, father George Carlson, was killed, one of a posse who went in pursuit of the robbers a few days after. Three men were killed near Humboldt's country. They were John Cullin, John Tins and a man by the name of Conner.

In the latter part of the year he was called to go and assist the British and French High Court in the military days of 1900.
