# WHAT WILL IT TURN OUT?

That Is What Will Goodell and Co. Are Anxious to Learn.

SUPPOSED GOLD DISCOVERY.

Sample Brought from Southeastern Utah to Be Assayed.—Creek George Walton Severely Ill by a Dog.

The faces of Deputy Marshals Will Goodell, "Uncle" George Walton (husband of the Third district court, and ex-Deputy Sheriff Chief Charles Sam Packer) were wreathed in broad smiles today. They confidently believe they have struck something which by and by will amply reward them for some little trouble they have been taking together for the last ten or twelve days.

Quite recently, while serving subpoenas in the southeastern part of the Territory, some 300 miles from Salt Lake, Will Goodell accidentally came across what may yet turn out to be a valuable gold placer claim. Upon his return to the city he communicated his find to Messrs. Walton and Packer (the former of whom is an old and experienced placer miner, and invited them to accompany him to the locality.

Tuesday week the trip started on their trip. In connection with a News reporter this morning Will was careful, however, not to "blow" too much of the (secret) "treasure" to the public. He said that they had located about 100 acres of land in the neighborhood of which they went, and had brought back several small pieces of gold from various portions of the area so staked out. They have already been handed over to a local firm of assayers, and the result of the test will be known either this evening or tomorrow.

In a week or so from the date the explorers will be back to the city, and should the official assay of the steps, a company will be forthcoming to work the find for all it is worth.
