His Respiration Has Improved, While His Strength Is Improving.

WASHINGTON, May 25.—At 5 o'clock Sheridan was resting quietly. Colonel Kellogg, one of the General's aides, expressed the opinion that the General is really better. He instantly recognizes anyone of his friends who enters the room and often inquires after their health. "At no time," said Kellogg, "has the General given up hope."

The following bulletin was prepared at 10 p. m. and is the latest received. He died at intervals, and about 10 p. m. he was in a deep sleep. After a short duration, from which he awoke feeling refreshed and cheerful. He has slept occasionally since that time, but his respiration shows great improvement, and his strength is slowly returning. The edema of the legs has entirely disappeared. He takes sufficient food, and his tongue, which previously was much coated, is now clear. His secretions are normal. He says he feels better.

Midnight.—There is little to add to the 8:30 o'clock statement. General Sheridan continues.
