THE EDITORIALS.

While there still remains at this writing one more session—and that the closing one—of the Bishops' meeting which our Welsh friends and the whole community have been attending during three days—the competitions are over; the work of the adjudicators is done, the prizes have been awarded, as decided, and nothing remains but the grand finale in which winners of previous contests are the performers—and that takes place this evening in the Tabernacle. It is not too early, therefore, to allude briefly to some of the striking features of the festival, and the pleasant resolutions that will be retained concerning it.

Artistically it has been a magnificent success—as deemed by every judge of music, eloquence, and literature who has given or ever expressed himself at all financially we trust. It has equalled the expectations of its promoters, for they assumed a tremendous monetary risk in prizes and expenses incidental, expenses, and their energy and conscientious efforts a reward better than actual loss. In a social way the event has exhibited perhaps its most distinctive success; there has been a cordiality and friendliness, even where the competition has been keenest, that is admirable as it is rare. The visitors are now in peace of the "impartial treatment" received, and those who have given them welcome have again shown to their own satisfaction that in the entertainment of the ladies and gentlemen it is more honored to give than to receive. A third and gratifying feature is the fairness and judgment shown by the adjudicators and the hearty acquiescence all round in the decisions given. Of especial and splendid prominence is the work of the adjudicators in music. It has been a genuine treat to listen to the criticism of these gentlemen, whose enthusiasm in the "divine art" would entitle them to a hearing everywhere, and whose absolute testiness and impartiality have impressed every auditor. We take it that no such discriminating decisions were ever before given in a western musical festival, and the educational and beneficial effects cannot fail to be immediate and far-reaching; it is a slight compliment to an audience to be taught, not only what the winning event is but why it won, and wherein it surpasses the others; and this was a feature that, we trust, was as pleasing and instructive to the audience that important and interesting as the musicians themselves.

We might be indefinitely multiplying to enlarging the festival as a whole, dwelling particularly upon its points of excellence. But it is perhaps enough to say in conclusion that it has been an unequalled and magnificent triumph from beginning to end, marking a red-letter period in the year's calendar of happy events, and winning for its promoters and participants golden opinions not only from their Welsh fellow citizens but from every soul in this and surrounding communities that is attuned to the adoration of the "Divine maid."

THE SAINTS AND THE SCRIPTURES.

The News a short time ago published a sermon by Elder Franklin D. Richards on the importance of keeping records. Among those who have read this interesting discourse is an editorial writer of the Christian Statesman. In the issue of that paper of September 21st he makes the following extract from Elder Richards' address:

"These extracts which I am now sending you are from a sermon which the Lord of heaven has given to me through the Prophet Joseph Smith, which he received soon after the organization of the Church in Kirtland, Ohio, and are found in the Post of Great Price, I quote from the same edition published in 1838, in this city. Further scripture concerning the same subject and other subjects may be found on pages 12, 13, and 14 of the Book of Mormon."

It then says:

"Now the Mormons with their profound reverence for the Word of God, thought of the curse pronounced on those who add to the things written to it?"

The curse referred to is, we presume, the one found in the last chapter of the Revelation of John, which the original is often apply as an argument against continuing revelation in the Church. It has often been shown that this is an obvious misapplication of the text, all the more strange because of the frequency and persistency with which it is recited as a shield against the divine truth.

When John, by the Spirit, was moved again to write, did any man bid add unto this book, (God shall add unto him) the plagues that are written in this book? if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his portion of this book?" It would seem anything "thus said" must be to the book he was then writing, the Apocalypses; for this book could not at that time, when the New Testament was not yet gathered into one book, nor even completed, enter the entire volume.
