DESTRUCTION OF PLANTATIONS.

Four Burned in the United States.

New York, Aug. 5.—A dispatch to the inhabitants of Havana says:

A party of seven rebels under the leadership of Alvaro Paredes, former member of Manuel Garcia's gang of bandits, was surprised Saturday near the insurgent ranks and fled upon an daylight intercepting by a squad of police under Captain Cueto of Quito, who, at a point in the suburbs of Havana, between Santa Domingo and Llerena, took refuge and his forces were dispersed and the members of the party arrested, shot down their chief, either in the vicinity or temporarily detained and subsequently freed from the fortress of Palacio and Jose Del Monte.
