

ON HIS TRIAL TODAY.

Peter Swenson has been charged with the offense of assault with intent to murder.

ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO MURDER.

That is the accusation made against him; his Uncle the Victim.

The trial of the young Swede, Andrew Peter Swenson, on a charge of assaulting Carl Anderson with intent to murder, was resumed this morning.

The prosecution is conducted by Assistant District Attorney Howard Avery Clegg, defense.

Anderson, now deceased, was the defendant's uncle. It is set forth in the panel of the prosecution that the two men met a little way from Anderson's home, which is about a mile and a half from Murray, on the early morning of July 1st, and that after a few words Swenson shot his uncle through the leg, shooting it in a fearless manner, and instantly killing a dog that was standing behind him.

Anderson was about a quarter of a mile away from home at the time, but he claimed that when he was shot he was brought to the city and placed in St. Mary's Hospital, where his leg was amputated by Dr. Pfeiferer, and subsequently he died of pneumonia. His wife was never informed of all the circumstances and said that she had no news of her mother until the second day after. She stated that he was in Salt Lake at the time of the tragedy, just before Anderson's death, he made a sworn statement, setting out that Swenson was his assailant.

Dr. Pfeiferer testified that Anderson died of pneumonia thirty days after he was shot.

Mr. Swenson, witness of Carl Anderson, testified that his son had been Swenson since he was a small boy in Sweden. He and Anderson were on very good terms. Sometimes they were friends, sometimes they were enemies. They have a son born January of the present year one; the alleged treatment of Mrs. Swenson by her husband, and were never on friendly terms afterward. She never remained with him, however, and he never made a sworn statement, setting out that Swenson was his assailant.

Dr. Pfeiferer testified that Anderson died of pneumonia thirty days after he was shot.

They have a son born January of the present year one; the alleged treatment of Mrs. Swenson by her husband, and were never on friendly terms afterward. She never remained with him, however, and he never made a sworn statement, setting out that Swenson was his assailant.

When the trial was resumed the witness W. A. Higgins, morning of Oct. 1, 1894, was called by Attorney Clegg. He said it was from Anderson himself that he learned deceased, and Swenson had friends.

James H. Griffin, of Union, also stated that he heard a shot fired at 11:30 a.m. It was not then quite daybreak. The sound came from the direction of Carl's home. Witness was unable to identify the gun or the gunner, and Swenson and Anderson, whether friendly or otherwise.

George A. Muller testified that early on the morning of the shooting he was at the home of H. W. Martin, who resided a half mile from the scene of the tragedy. Defendant was going toward Salt Lake City. This was about 11:30. Witness asked Swenson where he was going so early in the morning, and he replied to walk over. The spot at which he met defendant was about two and a half miles from Swenson's house.

Frank Smith, of Union, was next called, but testimony was泩nted.

Rufus Smith and Andrew Anderson, also of Union, were next examined, the latter stating that Swenson came to his house early on the morning of the shooting, and told him that he wanted to Salt Lake City to hunt for work on Saturday, but that hunting had been canceled of the shooting. He and his son returned to New Mexico. The shooting occurred the Sunday previous.

City Police Justice Grant H. Smith testified to the preliminary hearing on the defendant before him and the examination of Carl Anderson. In the presence of the defendant, who was seated when he shot him, and he replied that Andrew Peter Swenson did, pointing him out as the man. He also said that he was shot full (not as I express) when he was shot, also indicating that Swenson was about thirty feet away from him when he fired. His testimony was that Andrew Peter Swenson did, saying he was shot, and he was shot, showing him "Yankee" and "I will kill you." Anderson believed that it was a shotgun that was used upon him.

Cross-examined witness said that he was not satisfied with the explanation of the defense, and that he and Swenson were not on good terms.

Attorney Clegg—Tell all the information you have on that point? And secondly, the interpreter, has told?

Witness—Except that I understand a little from the gestures of Andrew, and a few words which could be understood.

Attorney Clegg—And for me? The accused attorney of the examination of Anderson before the court, and interpreted the answers correctly.

It was examined—All of Anderson's testimony was given to Swenson and transposed into English by an interpreter.

At this point the court adjourned till 4 p.m.

TO BE APPEALED.

In the case of Hoy Wright, the youth who was yesterday sentenced to the penitentiary for shooting a Negro, Attorney Bush now presented an affidavit by the defendant setting forth his interpretation of the transcript of his confession, and the same being required for an appeal to the Territorial Supreme Court. Commissioner said that the transcript of his confession was the expense of the defense.

The court took time to pass upon the affidavits.
