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TWO HEAVY DAMAGE SUITS.

Filed With Clerk McMillan of the Third District Court Today.

ONE AGAINST SALT LAKE CITY.

The Other Against the Salt Lake Street Railway Company.

In the Third District Court today, Albert H. Ekker, administrator of the estate of Martin J. Ekker, deceased, by his attorneys, Richards and Mayhew, filed papers in a suit against Salt Lake City for \$25,000 damages, alleged to be due the plaintiff for the killing of Martin J. Ekker, in September 1900, in front of the Hotel Utah, while engaged with officers in the construction of a sewer trench.

It will be remembered that a sewer trench was being dug at the place in question in a manner that greatly endangered the lives of the workmen. The excavation would be made from the surface to the desired depth, a distance of from ten to fourteen feet, after which a tunnel would be driven connecting the opening with a section of the trench farther on. The deceased was employed in the trench, when suddenly a fall occurred. When Ekker saw the excitement falling he made an effort to escape, but that was impossible, and he was buried beneath an avalanche of dirt about five feet in depth and aggregating several tons in weight. The fall occurred on the morning of September 10, 1900, and the body was not recovered until the afternoon and a score of willing workmen labored anxiously and with almost superhuman effort until about half past five before the unfortunate victim was disinterred. Death was instantaneous.

The plaintiff alleges in his complaint that the deceased came to his death as a result of the negligence and wanton manner in which the defendant constructed the sewer trench on which the deceased was employed at the time of the fatality, and that the same was done in a reckless and wanton manner, with care.

ALSO FOR \$25,000.

The papers in the case of John H. Lamb, of Salt Lake City, a street railway company were also filed in the Third District Court today.

The plaintiff complains, and for cause of action alleges, that the defendant, through the negligence, default and wantonness of its servants, caused the death of Lamb, who was killed by a street car on the Salt Lake City, on the 10th of March of the present year, while the same was being driven by a driver, named John W. Lamb, a minor child of the plaintiff.

On this showing the plaintiff prays judgment that the defendant be held liable for the death of Lamb, and also for the damages to the plaintiff in this case.

A Springville Dispute.

Three of the judges of the Supreme Court, Judge James and Justice Anderson and Justice McMillan, were occupied a portion of this morning in hearing arguments of counsel in the case of the city of Springville, plaintiff and appellant, against the city of Salt Lake City, defendant and appellee, represented by Mr. King, vs. John H. Lamb, defendant and respondent. The case was argued by Mr. J. W. St. John.

The real question to be determined was whether the plaintiff had any right of title in certain springs of water in and around Springville, and the case came up from the decision of Judge James, who held that the plaintiff had no right of title in the water, and that the defendant was entitled to use the water for its agricultural and other purposes.
