THE SEVENTH CONGRESS.

WASHINGTON, 16.—Hoar introduced a bill providing that in the case of the removal, resignation, inability or death of the President and Vice President, the successor to the Presidency shall fall on the members of the Cabinet, beginning with the Secretary of State and concluding with the Secretary of the Interior, in the same order as named in Washington's Cabinet and excluding the unconfirmed Cabinet officers.

The Senate took up the consideration of the national bank bill.

Garland said the proposition now presented was identical with that which he presented and urged last January, and he was glad to know that the House had taken it up.

He suggested the reference of the bill to the Judiciary committee, in which his own measure was still pending.

Blair introduced a bill for a statute in Washington of Benjamin Franklin.

The Senate bill authorizing the Oregon Pacific Railroad Company to construct bridges across the Willamette River in Oregon was passed.

The bill to re-appropriate \$850,000 to pay southern mail contractors for services prior to the accession of their States was taken up. After some discussion the bill went over.

The Senate took up the extension bill for the first time. A proviso inserted by the State committee, to exempt the national banks from injunctions and attachments by State courts, was objected to by Blair, who said he could see no reason for the exemption.

Allison, in charge of the bill, explained that the existing law gave the United States courts jurisdiction in relation to these banks. The House had inserted the provision giving the State Courts jurisdiction. The Senate committee had merely inserted the proviso that had existed in the national banking law since its creation.

Sherman said the bringing of suits against banks in the State courts was not to interfere with them, but by the issue of arbitrary process against the falling bank, for which the national banking law pointed out a different mode of procedure.

Yest replied that the different mode applied only to the case of bankruptcy. The House, in obedience to the popular demand, had adopted the principle that national banks were not to be subjected to the State and its people.

Jonas, La., contending that the statement of Sherman that the purpose of writs and injunctions, as applied to the national banks, is merely to marshal or protect the assets, and stated that in nine out of ten cases it was used as a means of delay to prevent some illegal or tortious act. He moved to strike out the word "injunctions" from the exemption proposed. Agreed to.

The committee amendment was voted down, yeas 24, nays 27. The affirmative vote was wholly republican. The Democrats voted no, and were reinforced by Dawes, Miller and Mitchell; Davis and Mahone voted yes.

The bill was proceeded with up to the sixth section, providing that all notes in the existing banks now in circulation shall be returned, destroyed or cancelled, and new notes bearing different dates and descriptions subscribed for them as they come and are redeemed. This section as passed by the House provided that whenever the old circulation was reduced to five per cent. of the capital stock of banks, the banks should deposit lawful money for that 5 per cent. amount.
