

OPEN LETTER TO SENATOR ALDRICH

Issued by Congressman Fowler
Challenging Him to a Joint De-
bate on Central Bank.

AGAINST ESTABLISHING ONE.

Would be So Much Discouraging and
Disheartening Favoritism as to
Destroy Individual Banking.

Elizabeth, N. J., Oct. 24.—Charles N. Fowler, congressman from the Fifth New Jersey district and former chairman of the house committee on banking and currency, today addressed an open letter to Senator Nelson W. Aldrich of Rhode Island, chairman of the monetary commission created by Congress and also chairman of the finance committee of the senate, challenging him to a joint debate in one or more cities on the subject of a central bank.

Mr. Fowler writes that he is opposed to the establishment of a central bank, under the existing conditions, because he believes that with it would come most discouraging and disheartening favoritism and the ultimate destruction of our purely individual and independent form of banking.

FOWLDER'S LETTER.

The letter follows:
"Just before you started for Europe in August, it was stated in the press that as a result of a meeting of the monetary commission, of which you are chairman, a central bank was to be advocated by your commission, and that upon your return from Europe you would proceed with a view of instructing the people upon our financial and currency needs, and recommend as a 'cure-all' a central bank."

"After your departure, there was an evidently inspired and well organized propaganda in favor of a central bank, conceived and carried on for the purpose of preparing the way for your home coming, and your arrangements to swing around the circle and initiate the people of the United States into the mysteries of your central bank plan."

"Inasmuch as I am convinced that the one thing above all others that this country does not want is a central bank, because it will not effect or accomplish the necessary reforms, but in the end will make a bad condition measurably worse, therefore, in order that the American people (who I know will decide this most important question now pending before them for consideration and determination, right as they did that of the gold standard, if only they be given an opportunity of having both sides of it fully presented and thoroughly discussed) may be informed as early as possible—I now challenge you to a joint debate upon the following propositions:

"First—A central bank will not effect nor accomplish the necessary reform of our finances and currency, is unsuited to our condition, will accentuate many of our present evils and precipitate and develop our evils of a most serious nature."

"Second—Our financial and currency problem must be solved upon economic lines of an entirely different character. I assert, you cannot successfully and beneficially superimpose a monarchical form of banking upon nearly 25,000 individual, independent, free banking institutions, which have grown up and developed in harmony with the principles of our republican form of government and are themselves republican in form and character."

"To establish a central bank in this country under existing conditions would be un-American, un-republican and un-American, and inimical to the general welfare of the people, because with a central bank will come a most discouraging and disheartening favoritism, the gradual breaking down and ultimate destruction of our purely individual and independent form of banking."

"I will meet you in joint debate upon the above propositions, in one or more of our leading cities—up to 10 or more of them, if you choose—at such times and upon such conditions or terms as may be agreed upon by us hereafter."

**COPPER RIVER RAILROAD
IS BEING EXTENDED**

Seattle, Wash., Oct. 24.—Word was received here today that the Copper River railroad, being built from Cordova, Alaska, into the interior, has been extended 10 miles within the last month, marking the completion of 82 miles of the extensive 200-mile project. Arrangements have been made to send an additional force of 1,200 men to Cordova to rush construction work during the winter months. More than 1,000 men are already at work on the line.

MORE CONGO ATROCITIES.

Brussels, Oct. 24.—New atrocities in the Congo Independent state have been revealed by an officer of a rubber company. He charges that between 1897 and 1899 a number of the company's agents tortured and killed many natives, posted armed sentries, chained and impressed the natives to force them to work and burned villages. The minister of the colonies has ordered an inquiry.

HENRY CHARLES LEA DEAD.

Philadelphia, Oct. 24.—Henry Charles Lea, widely known as an author, banker, scientist and publisher, died here today, aged 84.

The latest report deals entirely with the extent to which the disease prevails in the south. New Orleans reports two deaths from pellagra in July and two in August. FINE DETECTIVE WORK REWARDED

Man Wanted for Murder Com-
mitted in German is Ar-
rested in New York.

HIS OWN DOGS GAVE HIM AWAY

When Apprehended He Was Entering
House Where He Lived With His
Matrimonial Bureau Wife.

New York, Oct. 25.—The arrest of Frederick Gebhardt or Otto Mueller, as he was also known, is the culmination of an exceptionally competent piece of detective work. The skeleton of the body of Anna Lettner, who had been married more than a year ago to an Otto Mueller, revealed a murder, the matrimonial bureau and with their two children.

According to the police, Gebhardt, which he says is his right name, admitted that he had temporarily left his real wife to marry Anna Lettner; that he had gone to Germany with her as described, but that she had left him without explanation a few days after their arrival in this country.

L." and there were also merchant's memoranda indicating that purchases had been made in a small town near Hamburg, Germany. The German police were acquainted with these facts and they quickly discovered that the purchases indicated in the bills had been made by Anna Lettner, who a short time before had been married to an Otto Mueller in this country and who was then on her homeward journey with her husband to her old home in Germany. The Hamburg police informed the detectives here that when Mueller and his bride returned to this country, Mueller brought with him two dogs of the variety used for police work.

The local detectives, working on the case investigated the records of the German steamship lines and found a memorandum of a passenger who had arrived here at about that time with two such dogs. Through an expressman the dogs were traced to a house in Astoria, a part of New York City. It was there that the Otto Mueller, now under arrest, was captured as he was entering the house where he was known as Frederick Gebhardt and where he was living with the wife he had married four years ago, through a matrimonial bureau and with their two children.


