District Court Hatters.

The trial of A. H. Morris, administrator
of the estate of Charles N. Morris,
of Ogden, deceased, before the Probate
Court, was continued yesterday morning when the Fourth district
court opened. Two witnesses were
placed on the stand by the plaintiff
and that side received. The defense
then called two more, and it was
determined on the grounds that the
evidence under which the deceased
was riding at the time of his death
did not recognize the cause as a
passenger. The witness was
cross-examined by the defense.
The case of the Utah Oregon Lumber
Company vs. J. N. Rosenthal was
continued and was not com-
pleted when the court adjourned.
The case of G. J. Martin vs. Martin
A. A., also of Ogden, was for the sum
of \$1000. The suit of Weatherby Hill vs. A.
Frank was dismissed in plaintiff's favor.
People vs. Ray Bright, grand
juryman, defendant, was convicted
and sentenced to a year and a day.
William Evans, of Ogden, was
arraigned for burglary, pleaded
guilty and was waived time for sentence
when he acknowledged guilty.

An order was issued to the men of
Major Jones' Co. of the Cavalry, to
remain in Ogden, and the Commer-
cial National and City National banks
should pay all checks presented while
the receiver has money to deposit at
those institutions.
