CUBAN WAR NEWS.

Maceo and Gomez Riving on the
Capital of the Island.

FREQUENT ENGAGEMENTS FOUGHT

The Insurgents Fight an Interference
in Their War by the Cuban
States Government.

HAVANA, Nov. 5.—According to
insurgent statements the frequency
of engagements recently fought in the
vicinity of Havana is evidence of
the truth of the report that Antonio
Maceo and Maximo Gomez are re-
calling the forces under their command
upon the island of Havana itself, with
the intention of laying siege to it. They
will insist that Maceo has passed
the military line after having
captured Armero. As a matter of fact,
they are aware of the whereabouts of
Maceo. There is another instance in
the situation which is causing the
insurgents some terrible difficulties and
that is the visit of General Lee to the
United States. The Cuban General Lee
had been sent to the United States
to represent the insurgents in
negotiations with the government of
Spain. He has now returned to Cuba.
