PROFITS OF A NEVADA MINE

Two Weeks' Clean-Up of Round Mountain Mine Nets Twenty-Five Thousand.

COLORADOANS WANT CONTROL

Offer \$5 Per Share for Stock—Five Mills Now Being Operated at Round Mountain.

Capt. George L. Gordon is in receipt of a letter from Goldfield containing the information that the Round Mountain Mining company made a net profit of \$25,000 from the cleanup at its mill, representing the first two weeks of the present month.

Some time ago a syndicate of Colorado mining men, after visiting Round Mountain, made an offer of \$3 per share or \$1,500,000 for a controlling interest in the property and the matter was to have been considered at a meeting of the leading interests in Goldfield yesterday afternoon.

Capt. Gordon considers the Round Mountain mine to be one of the biggest gold propositions in Nevada and says developments down to the 500-foot level are of a decidedly satisfactory character.

"There has been very little news or hurrah made about it, no spectacular boom; but the men who own the mines have been busy with developments and there is not another camp in Nevada that felt the effects of the late financial panic so little as Round Mountain.

The Round Mountain company will post its initial dividend soon for payment in July and will probably amount to 10 cents per share, or \$100,000.

MONTANA SMOKE CASE
