SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 17.—Edmunds,

Briggs, Booth, Anthony, Wash-

burn, and Paddock having spoken,

the Senate adjourned until to-mor-

row. The Senate then, as a further

mark of respect to the memory of

the deceased, adjourned.

WASHINGTON, 17.—O'Connell

presented a resolution of the Union

League of Philadelphia against the

legislation proposed by the House

of Representatives, to the effect of

disposing of the Secretary of the

Treasury at par for gold coin in

silver coin of less value than gold.

Bright and Cleveland, in support

of the Secretary of the Treasury

to inform the House of the amount

of interest paid by government to

national banks on bonds held as

security of currency to them.

Adopted.

The House then went into com-

mittee of the whole. The House

was then called to order by the

Speaker, and was addressed by Blair

of New Hampshire, on the financial

condition of the country.

At the conclusion of Blair's

speech, the Speaker laid before the

House a message from the Senate,

communicating its resolutions on

the death of the late Senator Mor-

ton, and requesting that the House

do honor to his memory by passing

the resolutions which he would call

up to-morrow.
